## **Guide for Communal Reconciliation**

1. Do an Examination of Conscience before coming, asking yourself how and how frequently you have sinned against God and your neighbor.
2. When you go up and see Father, say: "Bless me Father for I have sinned. It has been (how long?) since my last confession."
3. Confess your sins: "These are my sins A, B, and C."
4. If you do not know how to confess, feel uneasy, or forget your sins, just ask Father to help you out.
5. Father may offer some advice and will assign you your penance.
6. Father will then forgive your sins. (Make the sign of the cross when he blesses you.)
7. Father will dismiss you; thank the priest; go back to your pew.
